Pretend you are a newspaper reporter whose job is to interview one of the characters. Write your interview. (Minimum: 1 page typed)	Choose one character in the story. Think about what the character was like at the beginning of the story. Write about how the character has changed by the end of the story. What events led up to the changes of the character? (Minimum: 1 page typed)	Write a friendly letter as if you were one of the main characters. Tell the reader what the character does, what the character knows or learns, and how the character feels. You can pretend that this is during the story or after the story finished. Be sure to follow the friendly letter format. (Minimum: 1 page typed)
Create a collage illustrating one of the major themes of the novel or provides a summary of the main events portrayed throughout the novel. Your collage can include magazine clippings, photographs, computer generated images, your own drawings, etc. (Minimum: 11'X13' paper)	Summarize the plot of the novel by creating a comic strip of the main events. If you choose this activity be sure to include elements of a comic strip; speech bubbles, detailed drawings, etc. The comic strip must include your own drawings, not drawings generated from computer, etc. You should also include a brief explanation for each of the segments of your comic strip (a few sentences for each)	Create a poster to represent either a character from the novel, or the main events of the novel. Be sure to include as much detail, illustration and color as possible to make your poster visually appealing. Your poster can also be used as advertisement for a movie version of the novel. (Minimum: 11'X13' paper)
Find THREE songs that you feel relate to some aspect of the novel. Include the lyrics and your explanations for why you chose each song. (Minimum: 1 ¹ / ₂ pages typed)	Write a long poem to represent the main events of the novel, a character from the novel, or something else related to the novel. (Minimum: 20 lines in length)	Your Choice: Choose an activity which is not included on this table that you would like to complete. It must be approved by me first, and it must be at the same level as other activities in the chart.
