Speaking & Listening Rubric (Halloween Short Story)

- **Tone** speaker almost needs to "act out" or perform the lines, especially when a character talks
- Pace not too fast, not too slow
- **Volume** speaker needs to project their voice. This mean the speaker has to be relaxed, pronounce words and have a certain level of loudness
- **Grammar** subject/verb agreement; colloquialism contained in character's dialogue only

Syntax – proper sentence construction (all sentences must have a subject and a verb)

Listening – looking at the speaker; attentive; avoiding conversation with others or making distracting noises
