<p>6. Moral [5 marks] - What is the theme of the novel? What does this novel have to offer teenagers? What does the novel teach us? Is there any life lesson that we can all learn from the novel?</p>	
<p>7. Resolution [5 marks]</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> What will happen to the characters in the future? Why do you think this? Are there any other "loose threads" (plot points that are left unanswered) in the novel's ending?
