For this assignment you will write an essay about someone you consider to be a hero. The easiest thing for you to do would be to choose a person who is a personal hero to you, but you could also choose someone that most people would consider to be a hero.

Try to be as specific and descriptive as possible in describing your hero.

Your assignment should include the following:

- Jot notes of your ideas
- A title page including name, class, assignment title, teacher name, and date of submission
- An introduction that states your definition of a hero and who your hero is
- 3-4 Body paragraphs, where you describe what your hero did and why you consider your hero to be heroic
- A conclusion

The rough draft should be approximately 2-3 handwritten pages and must show significant effort of correcting and editing your work. It is most effective to have a fellow classmate or someone else edit your work for you, because they are more likely to notice mistakes that you may not see.

The typed final copy (If possible) should be approximately 1.5 pages in length, double spaced, size 12 Times New Roman font.

You should submit your assignment in the following order:

- 1. Title Page
- 2. Final Copy
- 3. Jot Notes
- 4. Rough Draft

You will also choose one interesting detail or paragraph from your essay to share with the class once your essay is completed.
